(2) Town Clerk: Not present but Cartha Conklin read aloud the Clerk's monthly report.

(3) Justice Clerk: Not present but she furnished the Board with a copy of her monthly report.

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(4) Fire Department: Not present.

(5) Code Enforcement Officer: Not present.

(6) Highway Superintendent: Matt Stiles reviewed some of the projects that they are working on, including doing some ditching.

(7) Planning Board: They had their "Visioning" meeting last night 8/7 to share with the public data collected from the surveys distributed to the community last spring and get feed-back from the public. They had approximately 45 in attendance.

(8) County Legislature: Mark Rondinaro updated us on the latest sales tax figures. They are up almost 36% from this same time last year.
